This competition is held to promote the making of wine at home for enjoyment by the family. It also provides a time to learn and share information about the art of wine making. There will be a seminar, tasting of the prize-winning wines, and snacks. Come, join the fun. **No other alcoholic beverages** are allowed on the property except wine makers may bring samples of their wine to the pot luck, but no other time during the event is anyone allowed to bring alcoholic drinks on the property by direction of the management.

Remember, the number of entries is only **one bottle per entry**.

Awards will be presented on Saturday, September 13, 2014 at 11:00 a.m..

All entries must be checked in by midnight, Saturday, September 6, 2014

- Rules:
1. Only wine made by nonprofessional wine makers allowed.
 2. Each entry consists of one 750 ml bottle.
 3. Labels list: Name of Winemaker, Division, Class, and Year.

Example: **Jane Smith Division A: Class 01 - Red Dry, Merlot —2010**

4. All entries must arrive at Cowie Wine Cellars by Midnight, September 6, 2014
5. There is no fee for the Division F: Label, all wines are entered in this class.

Entry fees: \$15.00 first entry; \$6.00 per each additional entry (Entry fee includes **ONE** free admission)

6. Entry form and fees must accompany wine at the time of submission.
7. Prizes to be awarded:
Best of Show: Engraved Tray
Best in Class: Certificate
First, Second & Third in Class: Certificates
8. Winners will be awarded on a point system.
9. Special awards are given to promote the fun of the event.
10. **General Admission** to the event is **\$15.00**; this includes your glass that you may keep.

Friday Evening—September 12th, starting at 5:30, there will be a free potluck for all **wine makers and guess**. Please bring a dish of food, and a bottle of your wine (if you are a wine maker). Fellowship till the late hours. Bring a folding chair. Only homemade wines are allowed on the property this evening, no other alcoholic beverages may be brought for any reason.

Saturday -,September 13th - Awards of Winners, tasting of wines. Follow by the Annual Cowie Wine Fest and Grape Stomp.
